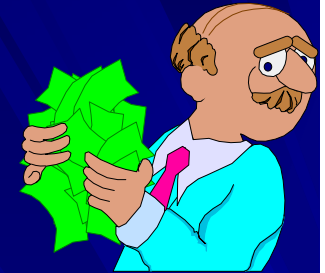

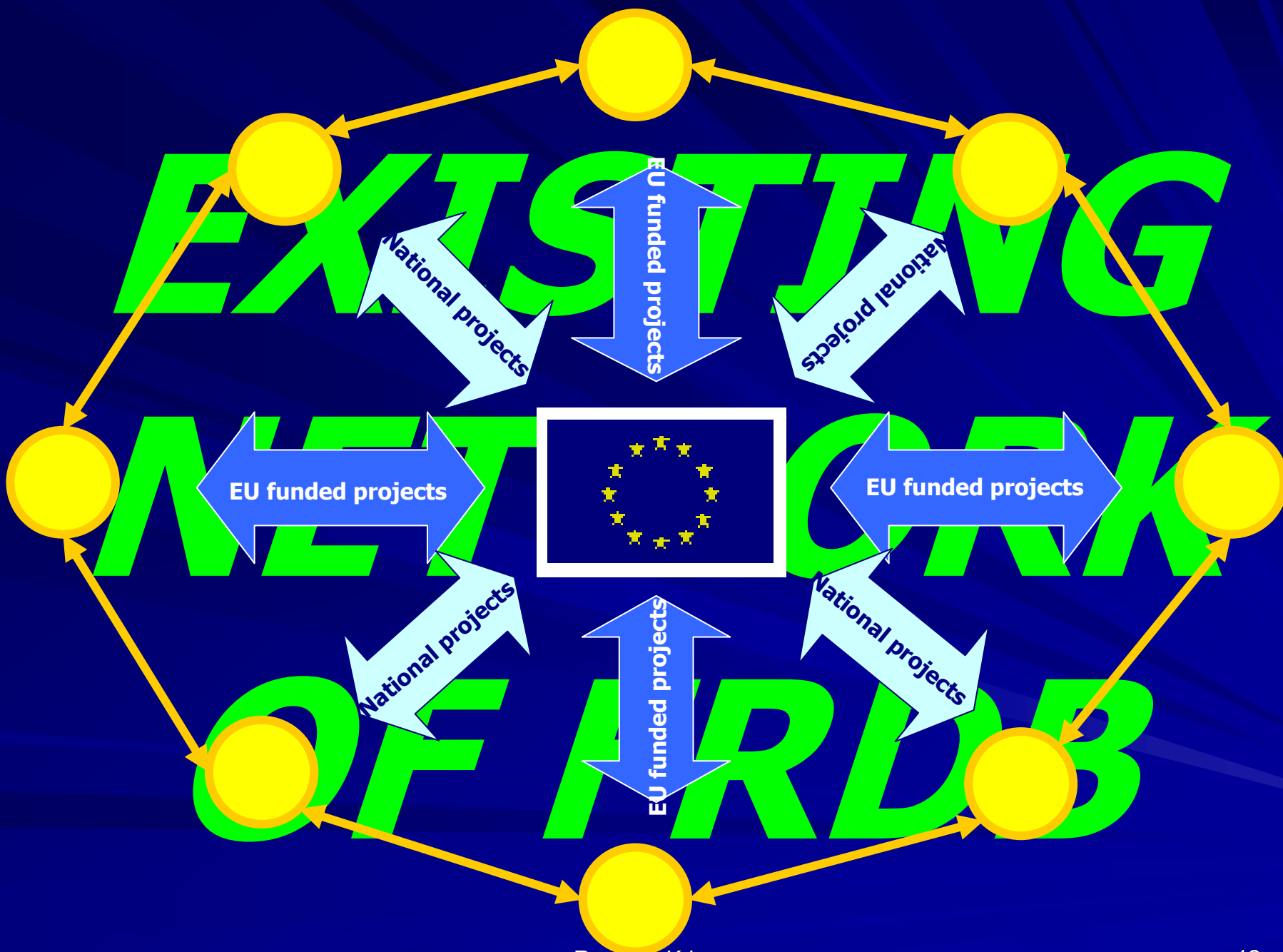

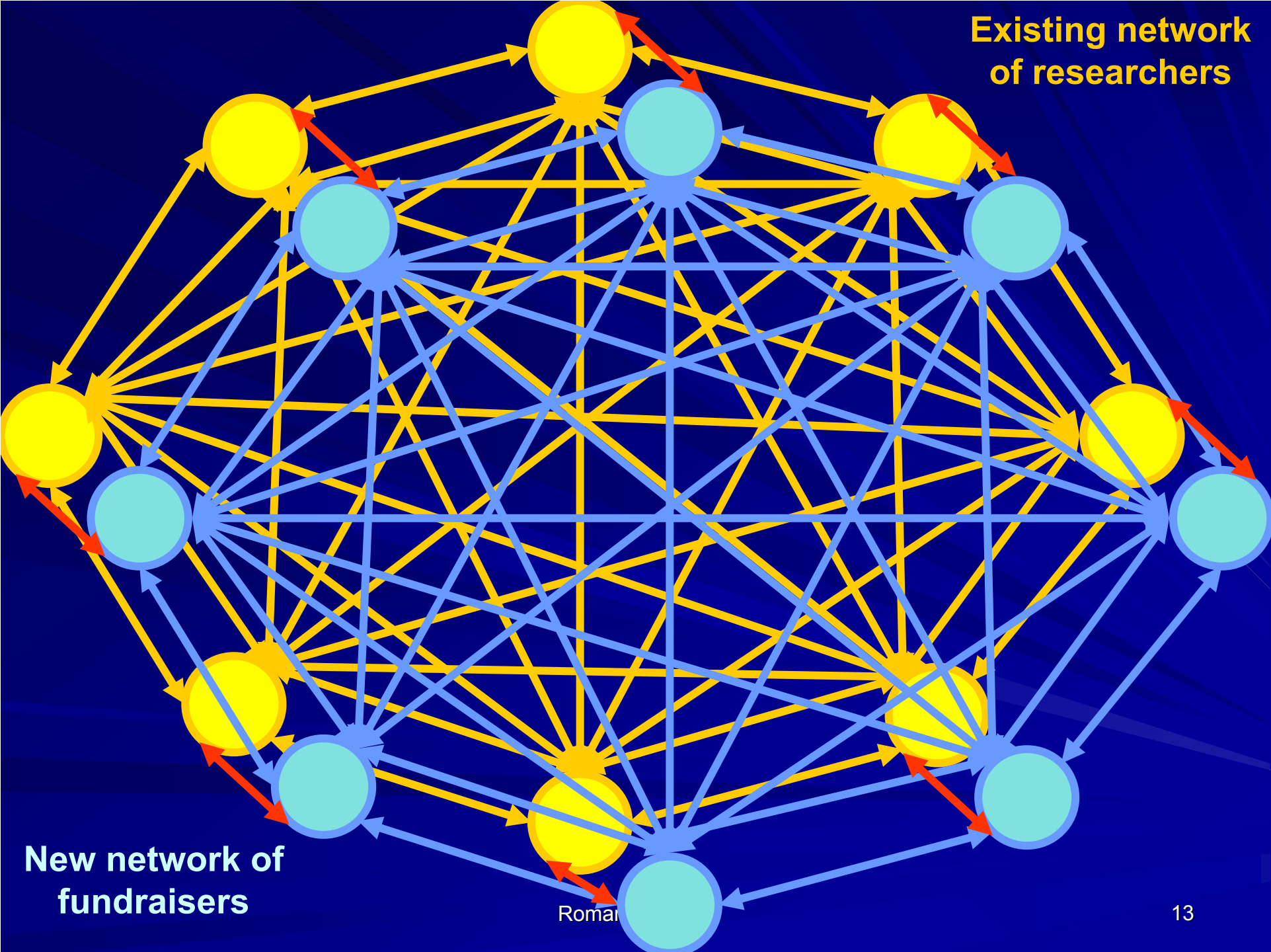

of researchers



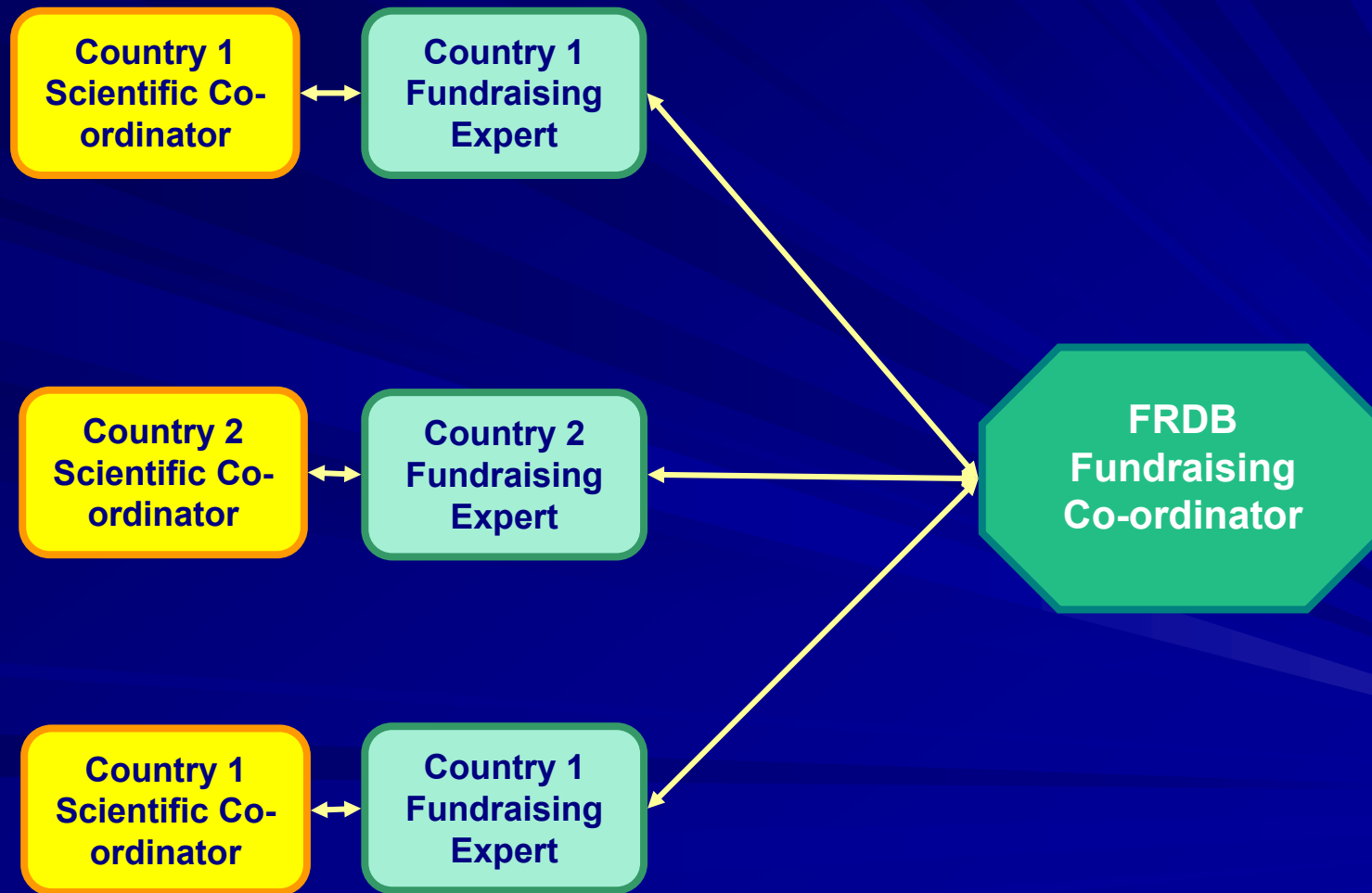

- Fundraising co-ordinator (Romana Krizova)
in Prague - flexible

Co-ordination activities

- **Training of National Fundraising Experts**
- **Fundraising Experts meetings**
- **Bilateral meetings with the Fundraising Co-ordinator**

Training of National Fundraising Experts

Ideally 1 participant per town (FRDB local centre) – should be recommended by the university:

- Individual person (from/outside the university)
- private organisation
- University department
- non-profit organisation

- Minimum number of participants: 8
- Maximum number of participants: 20
- Price: 300 € per person
150 € per each other participant from the same town (*recomended 2 persons from each FRDB network town*)
- Dates of the course: June 2003

Bilateral meetings with the Fundraising Co-ordinator

personal, videoconferencing or Internet connection

- Supervising of project preparation
- Supervising of co-ordination work and project management
- Supervising of reports writing and cost claims

Fundraising Experts meetings

in November and at the time of the general round table in spring

- Achievements in individual countries (either separate or as a contribution to FRDB Network)
- Problems faced in particular countries
- Opportunities on national or international level for FRDB Network
- Changes in existing programmes, priorities, calls for proposals and deadlines
- New programmes
- Transfer of best practice
- Spring round table:
 - Presentation about yearly achievements
 - Priorities of the EU with respect to activities of FRDB
 - Proposed topics for the next working period of FRDB (can be developed into EU funded projects)
