TO AGREE UPON:

Article n.1 : subject of the agreement

The University/Faculty/Institute and Romualdo Del Bianco Foundation undertake to draw up an agreement about the development of the institutional, educational and cultural relations.

Therefore, when recognising the mutual interest to proceed with one of the proposal of collaboration received, the University/Faculty/Institute of and Romualdo Del Bianco Foundation are entitled to determine, by mutual consent, the forms with which each of them can contribute to the accomplishment of what it is necessary to realise the initiative, each one according to its programs an institutional purpose. This definition can be made also through adequate correspondence.

Article n.2 : type of initiative under the agreement

This collaboration will be on a strict equal a mutual footing and can develop for the following type of initiatives carried out in the sphere of each own policy of relations with similar Institution of other Countries.

- participation to the weekly student's workshops for International Integration in Florence, organised by the Foundation according to its programmes, which usually start from November and end on February of each year
- participation of students coming from the University/Faculty/Institute of to the programmes of stage and/or training organised by the Foundation or by other Florentine firms supporting the activity of the Foundation (if you are interested you can apply for further information and papers)
- bilateral or multilateral meetings in Florence planned in order to start or consolidate those existing with other Universities from foreign Countries.
- organisation in Florence of seminars, cycle of lessons, meetings, conferences on themes that are relevant to the Foundation's philosophy of international integration
- others initiatives (exchanges of doctorate of research or of students, combined cultural initiatives such as exhibitions, conferences, publications and so on) in which anyway is involved at least one of the University from a foreign Country.

Article n. 6: others definition terms

Both parts engage themselves to exchange useful information – through publications or any other documents material – about the structure and the organisation of the foreign Universities involved, in order to improve the knowledge and ability in relations.

Article n. 7: life of the agreement

This agreement will come in force from the date of its stipulation and will be valid for one year; it will be tacitly renewed year by year, unless one of the parts cancels it at least 3 months before the expiration.

- therefore there is a mutual interest between the Romualdo Del Bianco Foundation and the University/Faculty/Institute of to establish a form of co-operation, which permits both Institutions to develop, each of them in the sphere of its institutional purpose, suitable relations with University from different Countries;

TO AGREE UPON:

Article n.1 : subject of the agreement

The University/Faculty/Institute and Romualdo Del Bianco Foundation undertake to draw up an agreement about the development of the institutional, educational and cultural relations.

Therefore, when recognising the mutual interest to proceed with one of the proposal of collaboration received, the University/Faculty/Institute of and Romualdo Del Bianco Foundation are entitled to determine, by mutual consent, the forms with which each of them can contribute to the accomplishment of what it is necessary to realise the initiative, each one according to its programs an institutional purpose. This definition can be made also through adequate correspondence.

Article n.2 : type of initiative under the agreement

This collaboration will be on a strict equal a mutual footing and can develop for the following type of initiatives carried out in the sphere of each own policy of relations with similar Institution of other Countries.

- participation to the weekly student's workshops for International Integration in Florence, organised by the Foundation according to its programmes, which usually start from November and end on February of each year
- participation of students coming from the University/Faculty/Institute of to the programmes of stage and/or training organised by the Foundation or by other Florentine firms supporting the activity of the Foundation (if you are interested you can apply for further information and papers)
- bilateral or multilateral meetings in Florence planned in order to start or consolidate those existing with other Universities from foreign Countries.
- organisation in Florence of seminars, cycle of lessons, meetings, conferences on themes that are relevant to the Foundation's philosophy of international integration
- others initiatives (exchanges of doctorate of research or of students, combined cultural initiatives such as exhibitions, conferences, publications and so on) in which anyway is involved at least one of the University from a foreign Country.

Article n. 3 : geographical areas where the agreement can be applied

The Romualdo Del Bianco Foundation will favour those initiatives which involve Cultural and University Institution from following geographical areas:

- Central and Eastern Europe
- Eurasia
- Asia
- Far East

Article n. 4: term of the agreement

The Romualdo Del Bianco Foundation will favour those initiatives, which are taking place mostly during the academic year, from November to February included of each year.

Article n. 5: creation of mutual links

Both the Romualdo Del Bianco Foundation of Florence and the University/Faculty/Institute of undertake to create a mutual link on their own web sites, in order to assure a wider visibility of each self and exchange of their visitors.

Article n. 6: others definition terms

Both parts engage themselves to exchange useful information – through publications or any other documents material – about the structure and the organisation of the foreign Universities involved, in order to improve the knowledge and ability in relations.

Article n. 7: life of the agreement

This agreement will come in force from the date of its stipulation and will be valid for one year; it will be tacitly renewed year by year, unless one of the parts cancels it at least 3 months before the expiration.
